



Flight Training Costs and Fees Academic Year 2026 - 2027

Note: These fees and miscellaneous costs are specific to the Gallatin College Aviation Program and its flight training partner, Ridgeline Flight School. These costs are in addition to tuition, room and board, and other college/university administered fees and costs. Flight course fees are based on average student performance. Actual flight training costs are based on **individual student performance** and could be higher or lower.
